What's Happening in the Community:

Traditions at North Bend is happy to announce some of the newer changes in the community: We now allow in-person visits of up to two people in a resident's apartment. These visits must be scheduled prior to the day of the visit and will require that our Receptionist escort you to the apartment.

Masks for Vaccinated residents are no longer required in common areas.

We now have church services in the form of Rosary being said weekly and mass coming in monthly. We also have a non-denominational service twice a month as well.

Transportation Updates:

Doctor appointment transportation is available on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 8 AM to 4 PM. (Must be able to be back at Community by 4 PM.) This transportation is door drop-off. We are not able to take residents to the office—if help is needed, a family member/friend must be able to meet the resident at delivery. These trips must be scheduled 24 to 48 hours in advance, and forms must be filled out at Reception. Appointments on other days will require additional cost, as will appointments that are further than the Green Twp, Delhi, west side area.

Transportation on Thursdays and Fridays will be for outings. On Thursdays, we will have more of a shuttle service to hair, nail, or lunch appointments or shopping from 9 AM to being returned to the community by 4 PM. This service will be for areas close to the community only—in order to ensure timely drop-off and pick up. Please sign up for the Thursday shuttle at the Reception desk. Fridays will be for scheduled outings planned by Activity Director.
